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**Amended technical specifications and tender Conditions**

**For Tender F.1(13)/RMSCL/Finance/2011/04 dated 5-8-2011**

**Clause 2(e)** should be read as “ The concern/company/firm which stands blacklisted/banned either by Tender inviting Authority or Govt. of Rajasthan or by any other State/central Government or its drugs procurement Agencies, on the date of bid submission, shall not be eligible to participate in the Tender. If a company/firm and any of its product was blacklisted for a specified period, then the same will become eligible after blacklisting period is over. In case the period of blacklisting/banning is not specified, the firm shall be eligible to participate after two years of the date of issue of order of banning/blacklisting.

**Clause 2 (c) (ii)** Following is added to the existing clause. “Product permission of brands shall be accepted in the tender submitted but the tenderer has to submit the product permission in generic names at the time of signing of agreement.

**Clause 5(f)** The clause should be read “ Attested photo copy of the valid import license in Form 10 accompanied with Form 41 (as per Rule 122 A of Drugs and Cosmetics Act) if the product is imported, The license must have been renewed/valid upto date. A copy of a valid license for the sale of Drugs imported by the firms issued by the licensing authority shall be enclosed.

**Clause 5 (k)** The clause should be read as “ Good manufacturing practices certificate (GMP) as per revised Schedule – M (for manufacture only) issued by Licensing Authority. The importer should produce the COPP of the manufacturing firm or a certificate which is at par with WHO-GMP/COPP issued by exporting

countries like USA-FDA approval, etc. The tenderer shall also furnish a notarized affidavit in the format given in Annexure-VI declaring that the tenderer complies the requirement of GMP (as per revised Schedule-M). The GMP certificate must not be older than six months from the due date of tender submission in case validity is not mentioned in the certificate.

**Clause 6(1) (i)** Should be read as “Bid should be type written and no correction in the price bid in whatever manner will be accepted.

Rates of each item should be quoted on a separate price schedule and the same should be kept and sealed in a separate envelop.

**Clause 14** Stands modified as “ For supply of medicines, the conditions of putting logo is relaxed and instead a rubber stamp seal is to to be “affixed”.

**Clause 16 (5)** is added “For imported drugs respective countries Pharmacopeial standards shall be acceptable (even if the product is official in IP)”.

**Clause 16 (1)** – Following is added in the existing clause “ The RMSC will deduct a sum of 1.5% from the amount of bill payable to supplier on account of testing charges.

Clause 17 (8) (i) should be read as “ If the supplier requires an extention in time for completion of contractual supply, on account of occurrence of any hindrance, he shall apply in writing for extention on occurrence of hindrance but not after the stipulated date of completion of supply.

**Annexure –VI** The existing sixth line which is “ Ref no. F.01(4)/RMSCL/TENDER/01/2011 dt 02-06-2011” is substituted with “ref no. F.01(13)/RMSCL/Finance/2011/04 dated 5-08-2011.

**Annexure – VIII – Checklist – Item no. 16** “WHO, UNICEFF, ISO certificate if any” stands deleted.

**Item No. 22** of checklist “ Document supporting the fact that the tenderer is complying with schedule L-1” stands deleted.

**Annexure XI Declaration and Undertaking**

**Point 4** is substituted with “ That our Firm/company does not stand blacklisted or banned by any state or central Government or by its procurement agencies on the date of bid submission, for supply of drugs/medicines in India.

**Point 10** – Stands deleted

**Annexure XII** Item code 367 – “0.25 mg/2 ml is changed to” 0.25 mg/ml

Item Code 14 – Ampule packing is also acceptable

Item Code 390, 391, 394, 397 – Blister packing is also acceptable.
